NPS SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIERS

NPS GENERAL RULES –

All NPS affiliated classes are judged under NPS rules. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by non-members, but only ponies owned by adult Qualifying or Life NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition.

The highest placed pony owned by a NPS members in each class go forward to the final. Qualification may go no further than 3rd Place.

Silver Medal Rosettes can only be won by ponies owned by NPS Qualifying or Life Members.

NPS Qualifying Rounds:

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part Breds are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern August 2024. The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final.

Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rule Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeited.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the

rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 2024

The NPS/ TALENT FORTE RECRUITMENT British Isles Area Supreme Flat Ridden Championship

This championship is for ridden stallions, mares and geldings.

Eligible ponies/horses are those that have won one of the NPS Ridden classes for ponies/horses at the show, excluding Leading Rein and First Ridden ponies. There are no specific registration criteria.

Rider's age to comply with the rules of the class originally entered.

The owner need not be an NPS member for the pony/horse to enter this competition or to qualify for the final but will have to become a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS to enter the final.

The qualifier may be judged within an open overall Supreme Championship where the highest placed appropriate (as defined above) pony/horse would be deemed the qualifier. The Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion Ridden ponies/horses at each NPS Area show qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship show. If the Supreme and/or Reserve Supreme has already qualified then the qualification may go to the third place, but no lower.

The NPS/AREA 15 British Isles Area In Hand Championship

This Championship is for youngstock, stallions, mares and geldings.

Eligible ponies are those that have won one of the NPS In Hand classes at the show. There are no particular registration criteria. The owner need not be an NPS member for the pony/horse to enter this competition or to qualify for the final but will have to become a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS to enter the final.

The Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion In Hand ponies/horses at each NPS Area show qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship show. If the Supreme and/or Reserve Supreme has already qualified then the qualification may go to the third place, but no lower.

The NPS/ASSENDONS Area Final Freestyle to Music

The owner does not have to be an NPS member for the pony to enter this competition or to qualify but the owner must be a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS to enter the final. If the Champion and/or Reserve Champion have already qualified then the qualification may go to the Second Reserve, but no lower.

RULES

Please do not leave your litter or muck out your lorries / trailers on the showground.

1. The organising committee do not accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to ponies, owners, riders, and spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
2. Owners enter entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the organising committee in any respect whatsoever.
3. In all cases, the decision of the Judge is final.
4. Exhibitors may not knowingly exhibit a pony that has been bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge or his / her immediate family or employer.
5. The owner of any horse / pony thought to be suffering from an infectious or contagious disease will be asked to remove it from the Showground.
6. Objections must be lodged with the Secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the end of the class accompanied with £10.00 that will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
7. The committee reserve the right to amalgamate or divide classes as deemed necessary.
8. No horse or pony under 4 years of age may compete in any ridden class.
9. All native ponies must be registered with their relevant Breed Society and shown in their natural state.
10. Whips/canes must not exceed an overall length of 75 cm (30 ins). If misused, in the opinion of the Judge, an Exhibitor may be sent out of the Ring and may also be reported to the NPS Disciplinary Committee.
11. Spurs are not allowed in any ridden class, or whilst warming up.
12. All riders must wear hard hats conforming to the current B.S.I. standards whilst mounted - All PAS015;VG1; (BS)EN1384 2017; ASTM f1163 04a onwards; SNELL E 2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS3838 2003 onwards. Handlers aged 16 years and under, of ponies in In-Hand classes must wear correctly secured current British standard hard hats.
13. A child must have attained their 12th birthday as of 1st January in the current year to either strip or lunge a pony except for stallions where the minimum age is having attained their **14th** birthday before 1st January of the current year.
14. Handlers of stallions and colts (excluding foals) competing in the In Hand classes must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. There must be no colts or stallions in Young Handlers classes. Riders of stallions must have attained their **12th** birthday before 1st January of the current year when riding small breeds (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B) and for large breeds (Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh C & D) riders must have attained their **14th** birthday before 1st January of the current year.
15. People leading ponies in Leading Rein Classes must be sixteen years old or over.
16. Colts 2 years old and over must have a current N.P.S. or Breed Society licence or as age laid down by their respective breed society.
17. Three year old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of four weeks old on the day of the show and must accompany their dams into the ring and be led alongside the mare as much as possible.
18. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
19. No entries will be accepted without the correct entry fee.
20. All horses and ponies must WALK in the horse walks to and from the rings.
21. All qualifying and membership cards **MUST** be taken into the ring at the beginning of the class. No class will be held up whilst cards are obtained.
22. Lunging is allowable only with side reins to a snaffle bridle or cavesson.

- 23. Riders are not permitted to wear earrings and body studs.
- 24. It is the Owner's due diligence to ensure that horses and ponies are not left unattended whilst tied to the side of trailers or lorries.
- 25. Entry fees will only be refunded in the event of the show being cancelled.
- 26. All exhibitors must ensure that they have Public Liability insurance for an adequate indemnity to protect against their liability and that of their handlers and helpers.
- 27. It is deemed that all attending The N.P.S. Area 28 Show have read the rules and agree to abide by them.
- 28. Stallions: All stallions and colts 2 years old or over must hold a Stallion Licence, unless otherwise governed by their Breed Society.

Ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle marker available from the NPS office or from any other UK society. *In Hand stallions (2 years old and over) must be adequately bitted and are advised to display a stallion bridle marker.*
